

ODFW's FFAC Situation Assessment
Top 10 Most Pressing Issues
February 2006

1. Manage for a range of habitats across the landscape
 - Landscape-scale habitat management
2. Manage for high quality aquatic and riparian habitats
 - Does not necessarily mean "hands off"
3. Fish passage at road crossings
4. Big game issues [early seral habitat (western Oregon), winter range, MOs]
 - Impacts to habitat and disturbance to wildlife
5. OHV use and road density
6. Invasive species
7. Recreation (hunting, fishing, and trapping)
8. Fuels management and critical habitat for wildlife
9. Practice adaptive management
 - Monitor, learn, then implement adaptations appropriately
10. Integrate previous planning efforts (including species plans)
 - Don't reinvent the wheel
