2. How will the Board of Forestry create a unified vision of how federal forestlands should contribute to the environmental, economic, and social sustainability of all Oregon forest resources?
3. How will the Board of Forestry develop and promote forest policies that keep working forests working?
4. How will the Board of Forestry promote incentives for sound sustainable forest health restoration practices, including the development of market-based solutions to reduce the risk of catastrophic wildfires and insect and disease outbreaks?
5. How will the Board promote the development of forestry carbon-offset markets as an incentive for managing forests, utilizing wood products and maintaining the forestland base?
