This document discusses the “possible improvements” to the performance measures that the Division identified in the 2008 performance measure report. This page is a summary matrix of that information. More detail is provided in the full report.

Performance Measure	Possible Improvement Action
Performance Measure 1	Agree to a method for calculating asset value Discuss establishing a more quantitative target Remove “for each forest” from the wording
Performance Measure 2	Consider adjusting to compare planned and harvested timber volumes; supported by three metrics Metric d: review results of the OSU contract on recreation as a component of ecosystem services; Metric e: change to “number of forest industry jobs” Metrics f through h no longer have data to support: remove; discuss need for additional metrics Discuss establishing a more quantitative target
Performance Measure 3	Metric b: remove “operators;” add “property” to the list of taxes
Performance Measure 4	Metric b: replace with a “fire risk” metric Discuss establishing a more quantitative target
Performance Measure 5	No adjustments
Performance Measure 6	Metric f: replace with “habitat suitability for wildlife
Performance Measure 7	Work to develop consistent data collection and reporting methods is tied to the recreation action plan and an education work group charter; both will proceed at a pace consistent with associated timeline Provide updates on recreation program activities and agency-wide education performance measure Discussions on revisions to metrics and establishing a more quantitative target will occur after the recreation and education work matures
Performance Measure 8	Work to develop consistent data collection and reporting methods is tied to the recreation action plan, and proceed at a pace consistent with its timeline Provide updates on recreation program activities Discussions on revisions to metrics and establishing a more quantitative target will occur based on the recreation work
Performance Measure 9	Discuss desired outcomes further, and methods to achieve those outcomes Discussion on establishing a more quantitative target will depend on the results of the above discussion
