- ✓ **Secure Rural School and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000**
Title II Projects - Title II projects can occur both on or off federally managed lands, but in some way they must benefit resources on Federal lands. The legislation states at least 50 percent of all Title II funds should be used for road maintenance and watershed restoration projects. Anyone can submit a Title II project, but must work with appropriate federal agencies, state and local governments, private and nonprofit entities, and landowners where the project will take place.
Timeframe: April 1

Title III Projects - These projects are submitted directly to County Commissioners for the county in which the project is taking place. Anyone can submit projects, but only very specific projects will be considered.

✓ VOLUNTEER AND RURAL FIRE DEPARTMENT ASSISTANCE

Grant Description: Financial assistance for Volunteer and Rural Fire Departments.

Match requirements: VFA – 50% money or in-kind. RFA – 10% match money or in-kind.

✓ ENERGY TRUST GRANTS

Funds to be used for: This program is designed to support renewable energy projects that do not already have an established incentive program developed and launched by the Energy Trust of Oregon. Projects will generally be awarded in the areas of small wind, solar photovoltaics, biomass, biogas, small hydro, and geothermal electric.

Who Can apply: Commercial, Industrial, Residential, General Public/Consumer, Nonprofit, Schools, Local Government, State Government, Agricultural.
