PERMIT CLOSURE PROCLAMATION

Number 02

Effective 12:01 a.m., PDT, October 4, 2016

By virtue of the authority vested in me under the provisions of ORS 477.535 to 477.550, I hereby proclaim a Permit Closure to be in effect in the following subject area:

Certain lands protected by the Walker Range Forest Protection District within Township 25S Range 8E Sections 2, 9, 10, 11, 16 and 17. [MAP](#)

Under this Permit Closure, except as to the owner's legal right of entry upon their land, entry to all subject forestland is unlawful unless entrants first obtain a permit issued at the Walker Range Fire Patrol office, 135393 Highway 97, Crescent, Oregon.

Permits shall contain requirements which are necessary to prevent danger of wildfire to life, forest resources or property and entrants shall continually comply with all such requirements.

The following public fire restrictions remain in effect within this area:

- Smoking is prohibited, except in vehicles on improved roads.
- Open fires, including campfires, warming fires and charcoal fires are prohibited.
- Possession of the following firefighting equipment is required while traveling in a motorized vehicle, except on federal and state highways, county roads and driveways: one shovel and one gallon of water or one operational 2 ½ pound or larger fire extinguisher. All-terrain vehicles and motorcycles must be equipped with one operational 2 ½ pound or larger fire extinguisher.

During periods of fire hazard conditions, the State Forester or an authorized representative may refuse, suspend, revoke or restrict the issuance of permits.

This Permit Closure shall remain in effect until suspended or terminated by the State Forester or an authorized representative.
