Re: Information Item - Approved Annual Operations Plan for 2010

The 2010 State Forests Annual Operations Plan for the Klamath-Lake District is attached for your review and approval. During my review of this plan, I have found that it is consistent with the Eastern Region Long-Range Forest Management Plan and the 2010 Annual Operations Planning Guidance.

This annual operations plan covers proposed forest management activities for fiscal year 2010.

During its preparation, this plan was reviewed by technical specialists from within the department and biologists from the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife. The draft annual operations plan also underwent a 45-day public comment period. During this comment period the district received two public comments. These comments were addressed in a response to the appropriate parties. There were no changes to the AOP from these comments.

Approval of this plan does not constitute final approval of individual project details. Individual timber sales are subject to additional review processes at the district and program staff level before approval for auction. The operations described in this plan may be modified during the final preparation and/or implementation. Modifications to these operations will conform to the process included in the draft Annual Operations Planning Directive.


Due to the recent budget situation some of the intensive management projects may be revised. Pct, road brushing, and surveying of property lines may be put on an extended time line for completion. Some of these projects may get completed through stimulus funding, while others will continue to be tracked and completed in a future AOP.
