Thank you for your letter supporting selective logging. However, Tunnel Selective was deleted from our sale plans after our marbled murrelet surveys discovered birds in the vicinity. The entire proposed sale area is now within a marbled murrelet management area that was established in the fall of 2008.

ODF policy prohibits harvest within marbled murrelet management area cores and restricts harvest in buffer areas to activities that are considered necessary to maintain the site.

We appreciate public review and comment on our plans. Thank you for taking the time to provide us with your thoughts.
