Special Forest Products for Personal Use
NO PERMIT REQUIRED except for firewood

No permit is required for collecting the following products and amounts for personal use from state forestland in the Astoria, Tillamook, Forest Grove, North Cascade, or West Oregon Districts.

Amounts of materials may be in possession per vehicle at any one time.

For commercial use, or for greater amounts or different products, permits are required.

See your local ODF office for obtaining permits.

Round or split posts – including: Alder poles and Corral poles	27 ft³ For greater volumes contact your local district office.	25 poles up to 5” diameter at the large end and less than 10 feet in length. Cut green poles or dead material may be taken from ditch lines or cut banks within 10 feet of the road surface and outside of firewood areas and sold timber sale contracts.
Beargrass Boughs Cascara bark Ferns (sword fern, bracken fern, and fiddleheads), Huckleberry, Manzanita, Moss Oregon Grape Other foliage and shrubs Rock (naturally occurring scattered boulders only - no river rock, crushed rock, or rock from stock piles) Salal Seedlings Vine maple Yew bark	12 ft³ For greater volumes contact your local district office	16 grocery bags Or Depth of 6” inches in a standard 8’ X 4’ pickup bed.
