Re: Minor Modification of the Tillamook District Implementation Plan

---

The Tillamook District Implementation Plan under the *Northwest Oregon State Forests Management Plan* was approved in March 2003. The approved plan provides for minor modifications as approved by the District Forester. Minor modifications are any modifications to the approved document that do not meet the definition of major modifications included in the approved IP document. (Major modifications are those revisions that result in major changes to the Forest Land Management Classifications as defined in OAR 629-053-0060; or those that result in changes to the annual harvest level ranges of more than 25% based on the combined acreage of regeneration and partial cut harvests.)

The following minor modification to the Tillamook District Implementation Plan will be approved prior to the approval of the 2007 Annual Operations Plan.

- The partial cut harvest objective has been modified from a range of 1,000 – 1,400 acres per year to a range of 1,000 – 3,000 acres per year (Chapter 3, Table 3-5, Table 3-25).

- The clearcut harvest objective has been modified from a range of 3,500 – 6,200 acres per year to a range of 2,000 – 6,200 acres per year (Chapter 3, Table 3-5, Table 3-25).
- The district will remain within the Implementation Plan range of 4,500-7,600 acres. If partial cut acres are increased to the top of the range in a sale plan year, then the regeneration harvest range will be reduced so the total operational acres do not exceed 7,600 acres.
