

## 2006 AOP Public Comments and Responses

Klamath-Lake District

Proposed Management Prescription

**COMMENT:** Clarify the juniper removal policy in **Lucky Logger** Timber Sale. Will juniper be completely removed or will old growth juniper be left.

**RESPONSE:** At this time, the district does not know if complete juniper removal will be done. Juniper removal is being proposed at the request of the ODFW to enhance wildlife and watershed values. The district will work with ODFW during sale preparation to determine the level of juniper removal.

**COMMENT:** For the **Fulla Bull** Timber Sale, clarify the discussions regarding "overstocked" sales with "understocked" stands. This seems like a contradiction.

**RESPONSE:** This comment refers to the prescription for stand 124. While the overall stand density indicates overstocking, there are portions of the stand which are understocked. These are the areas that will be targeted for group selections. This will be clarified in the AOP.

### Estimated Resource Outputs

**COMMENT:** Does the long-term monitoring plan provide enough information to evaluate the relationship between harvest volume and regrowth volume? This relationship needs to be established to ensure regrowth is occurring at the same rate as the harvests.

**RESPONSE:** The sustainability of the harvest level was thoroughly analyzed during the long-range planning process. In addition, continuous re-inventory following management activities is used to validate that over-harvesting is not occurring.
