Fish: Species List, Status, and Habitat

The following table lists species of fish that are known to be present or are likely to occur on the Elliott State Forest. Biologists at the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife exercised their professional judgment in compiling this list. All of the species are known to occur on the Elliott, based on direct evidence such as sighting, surveys, and census.

The table lists the fish in three groups: salmonids in forest streams, non-salmonids in forest streams, and fish in Loon Lake. Keys to the “Status” and “Habitat” columns are at the bottom of each page.
