 - h. Do you believe there is an adequate level of institutional commitment and resources allocated for continued full implementation and reporting of this indicator into the future?
 - i. What improvements would you like to see in future reporting for the indicator?
3. Report on public comment period for the 2011 *Forestry Program for Oregon*.
4. Receive reports from Roundtable participants on other recent sustainable forestry developments.
5. Identify next steps and discuss methods for ongoing communications and outreach to Roundtable participants.
