## Seedling Sources for the Cascades

October 2009

The Oregon Department of Forestry provides information to landowners about nurseries that supply tree seedlings for your region of the state. Nurseries have limited supplies of seedlings available during the year, and can run out – make sure you get the species and seed zone you need. The nurseries listed will grow additional species or zones on contract, which generally takes eighteen months to two years. Reforestation is required under Oregon law if you harvest below minimum stocking levels indicated in the Oregon Forest Practices Act. Contact your local ODF Stewardship Forester to learn stocking requirements and seed zone information.
