SUBJECT: **Consent 4** - Approval of Administrative Rules

Requested Action:

Approve the following rules:

- a. Temporary amendment of OAR 735-061-0210 relating Class C Third Party Testing Program Pilot.
- b. Temporary amendment of 735-062-0090 relating to early renewal of a driver license or identification card.

Background:

- a. **Temporary amendment of OAR 735-061-0210 relating Class C Third Party Testing Program Pilot.**

The Class C Third Party Testing Program pilot is set to end on October 31, 2016. There are three businesses currently participating in the pilot program. DMV has determined it is in the best interest of the citizens of Oregon and the businesses that have invested in staff, advertising and vehicles, to continue the program. It is also not in the public interest for DMV to absorb the volume of tests currently provided by third party testers because customers will likely experience a delay if they must schedule tests at DMV field offices. DMV is proposing to amend 735-061-0210 by this temporary rulemaking and then follow-up with a permanent rulemaking.

b. Temporary amendment of 735-062-0090 relating to early renewal of a driver license or identification card.

The current rule allows a person to renew a driver license or identification card 14 months prior to expiration. DMV established the 14-month time period in 2010 to allow flexibility for persons who may work or travel out-of-state for extended periods to have a reasonable amount of time to appear in person for a renewal of a driver license or identification card. DMV now proposes to reduce that to 12 months to comply with federal regulations regarding the issuance of a CDL.
