SUBJECT: **Consent 5** –Drinking and Drugged Driving Awareness Month Proclamation

Requested Action:

Request approval to submit the attached proposed proclamation to Governor Kate Brown for her signature designating December as “Drinking and Drugged Driving Awareness Month.”

Background:

For more than 20 years Oregon has proclaimed either part, or all, of the month of December as “Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Week/Month.” Through a schedule of coordinated events, the goal of this proclamation is to heighten the public’s awareness about the dangers of impaired driving. In conjunction with the national “3-D” month, the Transportation Safety Division would like the Governor to proclaim the month of December as “Drinking and Drugged Driving Awareness Month.” Numerous activities will be held throughout the state.

The Oregon Transportation Safety Committee and the Governor’s Advisory Committee on DUII have endorsed this proclamation request and support statewide efforts to reduce the incidence of impaired driving.
