Approve a request to amend the 2008-2011 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program to include the following three Transportation Enhancement projects from the Reserve List: Canyon Journey Trail: Mill City Sections; River Road: 2<sup>nd</sup> Street – Community Center Pedestrian Facilities in Elkton; and Main Street: Bonanza – Front Street Sidewalk/Streetscape in Echo.
7. Approve a request to amend the 2008-2011 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program to add construction for the Interstate 405: Willamette River (Fremont) Bridge in Region 1. The project will be funded with Bridge Program funds. Total estimated project cost is \$10,525,000.
