

## NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) will receive proposals for the following project on the 04<sup>th</sup> day of August 2004:

### **I-5: SUTHERLIN TO ROSEBURG SECTION of the Interstate between MP 125 and MP 139**

The project will include replacing ten (10) bridges, an interchange modification, and interstate maintenance between Sutherlin and Garden Valley (MP 125.38 and MP 136.5). The cost of the project is estimated to be between \$40 million and \$45 million.

Statements of Qualification must be submitted to Bob Burns by May 27, 2004.

The three highest rated Design-Build teams that have met ODOT's RFQ requirements will be placed on a short-list and be able to propose on this project.

After shortlisting the three highest-rated teams, unsuccessful proposers will be given an opportunity to review their Statements of Qualification ratings. Reviews will be coordinated by the Design-Build Program Manager. The Request for Proposals (RFP) will be released by ODOT on or about June 9, 2004 to shortlisted teams. After the RFP is released to the shortlisted teams, the RFP may be viewed at ODOT's Contractor Plans office, Room 28 Transportation Building.

This is a Public Work project subject to the Davis-Bacon Act. This project includes a DBE goal, which will be announced in the RFQ. The DBE goal is subject to Commercially Useful Function (CUF) requirements. "Buy America" requirements apply on this Federal-aid project.
