

**AMENDMENT No. 2 to
Price Agreement No. 7574
Liquid Magnesium Chloride Chemical Deicer**

1. This is Amendment No. 2 to Price Agreement No. 7574 (as amended from time to time the "Contract" or "Price Agreement") dated September 28, 2007 between the State of Oregon acting by and through its Department of Administrative Services, State Procurement Office hereafter called Agency, and Dustbusters Enterprises, Inc. of Wyoming, hereafter called Contractor.
2. The Contract is hereby amended as follows (new language is indicated by bold underlining and deleted language is indicated by brackets and strikethrough):

2.0 PRICE AGREEMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Section 2.3 is hereby modified as follows:

"2.3 TERM OF PRICE AGREEMENT: The initial Price Agreement Term shall begin on the date that DAS SPO signs the Price Agreement and end on July 31, 2009 [~~August 31, 2008~~]. DAS SPO may extend the term of the Price Agreement for additional periods, in one (1) year increments, not to exceed a cumulative total of five (5) years, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the termination provisions set forth herein."

3. Except as expressly amended above, all other terms and conditions of original contract are still in full force and effect. Contractor certifies that the representations, warranties and certifications contained in the original Contract are true and correct as of the effective date of this Amendment and with the same effect as though made at the time of this Amendment.

Certification: The individual signing on behalf of Contractor hereby certifies and swears under penalty of perjury: (a) the number shown on this form is Contractor's correct taxpayer identification; (b) Contractor is not subject to backup withholding because (i) Contractor is exempt from backup withholding, (ii) Contractor has not been notified by the IRS that Contractor is subject to backup withholding as a result of a failure to report all interest or dividends, or (iii) the IRS has notified Contractor that Contractor is no longer subject to backup withholding; (c) s/he is authorized to act on behalf of Contractor, s/he has authority and knowledge regarding Contractor's payment of taxes, and to the best of her/his knowledge, Contractor is not in violation of any Oregon tax laws. For purposes of this certification, "Oregon Tax Laws" means a state tax imposed by ORS 401.792 to 401.816 (Tax For Emergency Communications), 118 (Inheritance Tax), 314 (Income Tax), 316 (Personal Income Tax), 317 (Corporation Excise Tax), 318 (Corporation Income Tax), 320 (Amusement Device and Transient Lodging Taxes), 321 (Timber And Forestland Tax), 323 (Cigarettes And Tobacco Products Tax), and the elderly rental assistance program under ORS 310.630 to 310.706; and any local taxes administered by the Department of Revenue under ORS 305.620. (d) Contractor is an independent contractor as defined in ORS 670.600; and (e) the supplied Contractor data is true and accurate.
