RULE SUMMARY

These rules cover the annual adoption of federal motor carrier safety and hazardous materials transportation regulations and the adoption of international standards related to driver, vehicle and hazardous materials out-of-service violations. The changes ensure Oregon's motor carrier safety; hazardous materials; and driver, vehicle and hazardous materials out-of-service requirements are current with national and international standards. Amendments to the drivers' hours of service regulations were made to correct an oversight from a previous rulemaking that should have allowed intrastate drivers to use extended intrastate hours of service for sleeper berth operations and for the time card exception. A provision regarding utility service vehicle drivers was deleted, as it has recently been included in the federal regulations that are being adopted. Amendment related to medical waiver applications reflects transfer of that program to DMV.
