Temporary Insert to Chapter M, Fees

This insert will be removed from this chapter in the July 2026 revision.

REGISTRATION FEE INCREASES ● The 2026 Legislature (SB 1565) authorized an increase in DMV snowmobile registration fees. DMV will begin charging the new fees July 6, 2026.

Snowmobile: Snowmobile registration fees are increasing to **\$30** per two-year registration period.

Dealer Transactions: The registration fees collected are based on the registration period of the vehicle rather than the transaction date. Registration *begins* when DMV receives the transaction or an Oregon dealer issues a temporary registration permit.

Mailed transactions go by the postmark date if no temporary registration permit was issued.

NEW REGISTRATION

Dealer issued a temporary registration permit dated 07/05/26 or earlier	Collect old reg fee
Dealer sold the customer a trip permit, regardless of sale date, turned in the transaction to DMV 07/06/26 or later	Collect increased reg fee
Dealer mailed in the transaction to DMV 07/06/26 or later, no temp issued	Collect increased reg fee
Dealer issued a temporary registration permit dated 07/06/26 or later	Collect increased reg fee

A light vehicle trip permit has its own fee and allows the customer to operate their snowmobile for 21 days. It is not the same as a temporary registration permit. Temporary registration permits are issued by Oregon dealerships or Oregon DMV when full registration fees are received and plates cannot be issued. **The registration begins on the date the temporary registration is issued.**

Customers whose registration period begins prior to July 6, 2026, that wait to renew until after July 6, 2026, will pay the lower registration fee unless the registration has been expired for more than one year. For example, if a customer's registration expires June 14, 2026, they will pay the lower registration fees as long as they renew the registration prior to June 14, 2027. After June 14, 2027, a new registration period will begin and they will pay the higher fees.

This is the end of the temporary insert for registration fees.

General fee information

The correct fee to collect for any transaction depends on the type of vehicle and the service that is being paid for. To calculate the fee for your transaction, you will need to know the following:

- County where the vehicle will be registered
- Miles Per Gallon (MPG)
- Motive power (Ex: Gas, Hybrid, Electric)
- Vehicle type
- OReGO enrollment status
- Vehicle weight and length

Do not include the privilege/use tax fee on the application.

When filling out applications for title and registration, include the total registration fee amounts, including county registration fees if applicable, in the REG/REN FEE box on the application.

Title fee

The fee for title is based on the vehicle type, weight, and whether the title being replaced or applied for is a salvage title. Determine the weight of the vehicle even if the vehicle is not being registered. Oregon issues three types of titles:

1. Light vehicle title – standard title for most vehicle types
2. Heavy motor vehicle titles - based on the gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR).
Issued to:
 - Trailers with a loaded weight over 8,000 pounds (this does not apply to other vehicle types such as special use trailers and travel trailers).
 - Motor vehicles with GVWR over 26,000 pounds (does not apply to motor homes).
3. Salvage certificate – for all vehicle types

Passenger Vehicles

Passenger vehicle title and registration fees are based on the combined MPG rating as determined by DMV's VIN decoding software. Dealers can also provide the combined MPG rating to DMV for vehicles on the Application for Title and Registration, [Form 226](#).

If the combined MPG rating is available for the vehicle, include that on the application so that DMV can assess the correct fees. Sometimes the VIN does not decode with the MPG rating. You can find a vehicle's combined MPG rating at fuelconomy.gov.

Title fees

Oregon does not charge differently for replacement or duplicate titles. The title fee chart below applies to replacement, duplicate and title transfer applications.

Passenger vehicles are eligible for 2- or 4-year registration. The following chart shows the passenger registration fee information based on the MPG rating.

**County-owned vehicles can have regular (tree plate) passenger registration at their request.

County registration fees

County registration fees are based on the customer's vehicle address, residence address, or business address (in that order) at the time of application for registration.

Most vehicle types are subject to the county registration fees.

Multnomah County: Multnomah County has imposed an additional registration fee of \$56 per year of registration. Heavy trailers with a permanent registration are assessed a one-time county registration fee of \$10.

Washington County: Washington County has imposed an additional registration fee of \$30 per year of registration. Heavy trailers with a permanent registration are assessed a one-time county registration fee of \$10. Motorcycles and mopeds will pay an additional \$17 per year of registration.

Clackamas County: Clackamas County has imposed an additional registration fee of \$30 per year of registration. Heavy trailers with a permanent registration are exempt from Clackamas County Registration fees. Light trailers pay \$5 per year for Clackamas County Registration fees.

Vehicle types exempt from county registration fees:

- Disabled Veteran plates
 - Ex-POW plates
 - Snowmobiles
 - ATVs
 - Fixed load vehicles
 - Antique vehicles
 - Special interest vehicles
 - Government-owned or operated vehicles
 - School buses or school activity vehicles
 - Law enforcement undercover vehicles
 - Vehicles registered proportionally for interstate operation
 - Vehicles with a registration weight of 26,001 pounds or more
 - Farm vehicles
 - Travel trailers, campers and motor homes
- Vehicles registered to an employment address as provided in ORS 802.250 when residence address is not within county of employment address

Plate Manufacturing

License plate manufacturing and replacement fees are charged in addition to registration fees. Plate backgrounds are then charged an additional surcharge fee. The fees will depend on the plate type and background selected, as well as the number of plates issued. The following plate fees are in addition to the registration fees listed earlier in this chapter.

Replacement plate fee

When plates are issued in **conjunction with original registration** there is no replacement fee. Original registration is issued for vehicles purchased new with an MCO, purchased without plates or registration, or brought to Oregon for the first time from another state.

Collect the plate fee and the registration fee (see fee charts), and custom or group plate fee, if applicable.

When plates are lost or damaged and must be replaced, a replacement fee of \$12 per transaction is charged in addition to the plate fee.

Replacement plate fee example:

If the customer wants to apply for replacement plates at any time, regardless of the plate background, they will pay the replacement fee of \$12 in addition to the plate fee.

Plate Backgrounds

Some plate backgrounds have additional surcharges at issuance and renewal. These surcharges do not apply when a customer is replacing plates that have been lost or damaged with the same background type.

For example, if a customer had Salmon plates on their vehicle, and the plates have become damaged and need to be replaced, the plate fee and replacement fee will be charged, but the Salmon surcharge will not.

Tree plates

The tree plate background is the only option for light trailers and is the standard option for passenger vehicles. There is no background surcharge for tree plates.

This background is also used on the following group plate types:

- Most non-veteran related group plates
- National Guard plates
- Elected Official plates
- Full-Sized Disabled Veteran plates (not moped or motorcycle)

The tree plate was the original graphic plate. When mentioned in older DMV literature, "graphic" means the tree plate.

Pacific Wonderland plates

“OR 150” Pacific Wonderland plates may be issued to passenger vehicles only and may not be issued with a custom or ham configuration.

Pacific Wonderland plates are \$100 per set of plates.

Registration and replacement fees for “OR 150” Pacific Wonderland plates are the same as for regular registration for passenger vehicles plus a surcharge of \$100 per set of plates whether it is 2-year or 4-year registration. The surcharge is required only when “OR 150” Pacific Wonderland plates are initially issued.

Salmon plates (Issued only to passenger vehicles)

The Salmon plate surcharge is distributed to two funds: half to the Watershed Conservation Operating Fund and half to the State Parks and Recreation Department Fund.

Salmon plate surcharge is \$7.50 per plate per year of the registration period.

When Salmon plates are issued in conjunction with original registration (new vehicles or new to Oregon) the fees collected are the surcharge of \$7.50 per plate per year of the registration period, the plate fee and the registration fee.

When Salmon plates are issued to an Oregon-registered vehicle, the fees collected are the replacement fee, the Salmon plate surcharge, plate fee, and, if at renewal, the registration renewal fee.

Crater Lake plates (Issued only to passenger vehicles)

The surcharge for Crater Lake plates is distributed to the Oregon Community Foundation for use on Crater Lake National Park projects.

Crater Lake plate surcharge is \$15.00 per plate. Surcharge is not charged at renewal.

When Crater Lake plates are issued in conjunction with original registration (new vehicle or new to Oregon) the fees collected are the surcharge of \$15 per plate, the plate fee, and the registration fee.

Cultural plates (Issued only to passenger vehicles)

The surcharge for Cultural plates is distributed to the Trust for Cultural Development to fund specific arts, heritage, and humanities programs.

Cultural plate surcharge is \$25.00 per plate.

The Cultural plate surcharge does not double with four-year registration. The surcharge is collected at initial issuance and at each renewal.

When Cultural plates are issued in conjunction with original registration (new vehicle or new to Oregon) the fees collected include the surcharge of \$25 per plate, the plate fee and the registration fee.

Portland Trail Blazers plates *(Issued only to passenger vehicles)*

The surcharge, minus DMV administrative costs, is transferred to the Trail Blazers Foundation. The foundation uses the surcharge proceeds received to issue grants for youth-related programs and initiatives.

The Portland Trail Blazers plate surcharge does not double with four-year registration. The surcharge is collected at initial issuance and at each renewal.

When Portland Trail Blazers plates are issued in conjunction with original registration (new vehicle or new to Oregon) the fees collected are the surcharge of \$40, the plate fee and the registration fee.

Portland Trail Blazer plate surcharge is \$40.00 per set of plates.

Wine Country plates *(Issued only to passenger vehicles)*

The surcharge for Wine Country plates is distributed to the Oregon Tourism Commission to support the promotion of agricultural and culinary tourism in Oregon. Wine Country plates may be transferred to another vehicle of the same type. See [Chapter K](#) for information about plate transfer requirements.

The Wine Country plate surcharge does not double with four-year registration. The surcharge is collected at initial issuance and at each renewal.

When Wine Country plates are issued in conjunction with original registration (new vehicle or new to Oregon) the fees collected are the surcharge of \$30, the plate fee and the registration fee.

Wine Country plate surcharge of \$30.00 per set of plates.

Special Registration Plate Program

Special Registration Plate Program plates may be issued for passenger vehicles. Currently this program includes:

- Golf Oregon
- Gray Whale
- Oregon Zoo
- OSU Beaver
- Pollinator Paradise
- Smokey Bear
- UOAA Duck
- Watch for Wildlife

The surcharge does not double with four-year registration. The surcharge is collected at initial issuance and at each renewal.

When Special Registration Plate Program plates are issued in conjunction with original registration (new vehicle or new to Oregon) the fees collected are the surcharge of \$40, the plate fee and the registration fee.

Special Registration Plate Program plate surcharge of \$40.00 per set of plates.

Group plates

Most group plates are only available to passenger vehicles. However, Veteran Recognition plates are also available for motorcycles and mopeds. To assist a customer in applying for

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group plates, and for more information about qualifying for a group plate, and for group plate transfer information, see [Chapter K](#).

When the plates are issued or renewed, the surcharge collected (see [surcharge fee chart](#) in this chapter) goes into an account for the group.

When group plates are issued in conjunction with original registration (new vehicles or new to Oregon) the fees collected are the surcharge, the plate fee and the registration fee.
