## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

• Use this form to comply with odometer certification requirements when an odometer on any vehicle is serviced, repaired or replaced and the odometer reading changes.

• If you service, repair or replace an odometer and you change the odometer reading, you must file this certification with DMV within 10 days of the date the work is completed. (See "EXEMPT VEHICLES AND PENALTIES," below.)

• This form must be completed by the person who did the work on the odometer. It must be completed in full, signed and dated.
