

## Tips for using A Guide To Oregon Covered Bridges

For the best detail in each map, set your Acrobat Reader to “Actual Size.” A screen resolution of at least 1024 by 768 with 65,536 colors is recommended for optimal display.

All of the pages in this document have bookmarks that allow the user to jump to other documents in the guide. Bookmarks can be displayed by pressing the Show/Hide Navigation Button on the tool bar.



Not all of the bridges require a detailed map to show their location. In some instances, a general map with the given driving directions can easily guide the user to the bridge. Several bridges, however, require a more detailed map.

In any map, if you can't find a bridge that is associated with the map, access the bookmarks and select the bridge name listed under “Find In Current View.” This will move the map to display the bridge location.

### Page Navigation



Move within the document to the first page



Move within the document to the previous page



Move within the document to the next page



Move within the document to the last page

These are used in documents that have multiple pages like this one, and the Index and the Driving Directions.

### View Navigation



Go To Previous View



Go To Next View

These refer to the views that have been displayed on the screen. If you have used the hand to pan around, going to the previous view will return you to the view prior to panning. If the previous view was another map, this will return you to the previous map.

It may be easier to use the bookmarks to jump to other views. For example, if you are viewing the information document on an individual bridge and you press the Map button, the most detailed map available for that bridge will be displayed. If you cannot find the bridge, use the bookmarks to pan the map and move the bridge into view. If you want to display a more general map of that area, use the bookmarks to return to the previous map.

# Tips for using A Guide To Oregon Covered Bridges

## Bridge Tags



Bridge locations are identified by a tag displaying the bridge name and a blue target with a red center to show the bridge location. By clicking on the tag, the bridge information will be displayed.

## Zoom Areas



Some of the maps show bridges within blue rectangles. These rectangles are zoom areas. By clicking within the rectangle, but not on a bridge tag, a more detailed map of the area will be displayed.

## The Hand



If the current document is bigger than the view displayed, move the cursor over the document until an open hand appears. Press and hold the left mouse button to make the hand grab the page. Moving the mouse will then drag the document around the view window. If you move the open hand over a zoom area or bridge tag, the hand will change to a pointing hand. Pressing the left mouse button will move to a more detailed map or display the bridge information.

You can also move to a bridge label within a view by using the bookmarks as previously described.

## Zooming Within A View

To increase the magnification within Acrobat Reader of a given view, press the “Ctrl” and the “+” keys simultaneously. To decrease the magnification, press the “Ctrl” and the “-“ keys simultaneously.
