**02050.40 – Evaporation Reducer, Concrete**

We require concrete evaporation reducer materials to come from the QPL. This is a list of materials that are used to reduce the evaporation of water from the concrete surface. The evaporation reducer liquid will be placed on a freshly placed concrete surface immediately after texturing the concrete surface and prior to placement of the curing blanket.

Note: As of September 2008, we have dropped this category from our 2008 Standard Specifications, so we are not adding any new products to this list. We will maintain the current QPL Listing of these products, and allow their use on projects bid using the 2002 Standard Specs.

- Specifications:
1. Produce a continuous mono-molecular film on fresh concrete surfaces
  2. Shall be Federally VOC compliant
  3. Shall be a water-based liquid
  4. Colored/tinted to assist in uniform application of product. Must be formulated so that coloring disappears once concrete surface is dry.
  5. Shall have no effect on the concrete hydration process
