

Standard Guidelines for Product Review
Temporary Sign Substrate - Lightweight;
Section 00225.11

Following are a list of requirements to if you would like to submit a product to ODOT for consideration and placement of Lightweight Temporary Sign Substrate products suitable for workzone signing onto the Qualified Products List (QPL).

Specifications - We require the product to comply with the following:

- (a) Crash Test approval from FHWA (Note, if you are submitting for the portable sign support category, you must furnish FHWA approval for your product when used with all currently approved portable sign supports on the QPL.)
- (b) The product must be compatible with all currently approved sign sheetings on the QPL.
- (c) The product must be durable and able to function in tough conditions including high winds, wet, dry, cold, and hot climates.

To apply for inclusion on the QPL, submit the following:

- Specify: Post Mount Portable Sign Support Mount
- [Preliminary Information for Product Evaluation Form](#).
- Brochure and installation instructions.
- Independent test results of representative samples showing durability and functionality as listed above.
- Approval from FHWA for Crashworthiness.
- Copies of letters from Avery Dennison, Nippon Carbide, and 3-M stating that using your substrate with their specific sign sheeting won't void the sign sheeting warranty.
- 4 small samples (each approximately 6" x 8") with sheeting attached.
