Re: Pass Creek (B Street) Bridge No. 06940 – City of Drain

Bob,

In regards to the OTIA III funding guidelines, the City of Drain is requesting financial support to replace the Pass Creek Bridge (No. 06940). The one hundred ten foot long two-lane structure was constructed in 1948. The bridge serves as the only access for trucks, school buses, and emergency vehicles (ambulance & fire) to about half of the City and is the primary access for pedestrian, bicycle, and residential vehicular traffic. The bridge is on a dead end. A narrow and height restricted RR undercrossing exists under two bents of a nearby timber trestle RR bridge. This crossing may be used by cars, however, the clear opening does not allow for other vehicular traffic.
