It's a sweep for ODOT projects!

ODOT Project Manager Allison Hamilton was honored at the annual Women's Transportation Seminar conference, where the Oregon Solar Highway Demonstration Project received the 2008 "Project of the Year" award.

Hamilton accepted the award on behalf of everyone at ODOT involved in getting the nation's first "solar highway" up and running at the intersection of I-5 and I-205 in the Portland metro area. The intersection lights are scheduled to be operated by solar power beginning this month.
