

## **Activity 307 Hazardous Material Cleanup (Non-ODOT Generated)**

Activity 307 involves all work associated with hazardous materials abandoned, leaked, or spilled on ODOT property by parties other than ODOT. It includes identifying, testing, removing, and disposing of the involved material and restoring the site as needed.

Refer to Activity 093 if ODOT generated the hazardous material.

Follow instructions in the ODOT *Employee Guide to Highway Incidents and Hazardous Material Response* and the *Emergency Response Handbook*. Also refer to discussion in the Emergency Operations and Incident Response section of this Guide.

Implement appropriate methods to control erosion, sedimentation, and pollutants or contaminants, including those discussed in the *ODOT Routine Road Maintenance Water Quality and Habitat Guide Best Management Practices*.

Seek assistance from the District Manager, Region Hazmat Coordinator, and the Region Environmental Coordinator as needed. If needed, ask the Transportation Operations Center (TOC) to request assistance from emergency response agencies.

### Measurement of Accomplishment, Expenditure Account, Charge Activity

Measurement is number of worker hours involved. Request the Maintenance Management System (MMS) Unit to establish a special EA for each situation. Charge work to TEAMS Activity 307 unless a Claims Against Others (CAO) EA is opened in which case charge TEAMS Activity 305.
