

Activity L11

Approach Permits and Access Management

Activity L11 involves processing applications for and administering and monitoring permits for constructing and operating an approach to a State Highway, as required by the ODOT Access Management Program. Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Reviewing the application for the permit.
- Analyzing impacts to ODOT facilities and operations.
- Analyzing needed traffic control or restrictions.
- Meeting with the applicant and/or other concerned or affected parties.
- Accomplishing any needed indenture or grant of access location.
- Issuing the permit.
- Monitoring the permit activity, including any needed construction.
- Performing other work related to the Access Management Program.

Refer to Activity L10 for work related to miscellaneous permits.

Refer to Activity L19 for work related to utility permits.

Use Activity P50 (not included in this Guide) for work involving general access management planning. Contact the Region Access Management Engineer for information.

Obtain or establish an outside billing EA, as appropriate or as directed by the District Manager, if inspection, review, analysis, or other work beyond basic understanding and processing of the permit is required. Refer to discussion in Activity 305.

Measurement of Accomplishment, Expenditure Account, Charge Activity

Measurement is number of worker hours involved. Expenditure account type is Crew PRMT EA. Charge all work to TEAMS Activity L11.
