- Permanent acknowledgment sign
- Portable work zone sign
- Safety vests
- Safety training videos
- Litter bags and ties
- Flags
- Pick up and disposal of litter

Adoptee Provides

- First aid kit
- Drinking Water
- Sturdy leather shoes or boots
- Gloves
- Long sleeves
- Appropriate clothes for the season
- Grapplers

Vehicle Use

- Carpool to site
- Park off roadway
- Park off shoulder

Requirements

- Must be age 16 or older
- Able to make a 1-2-3 year commitment
- Pick up when necessary
- Attend to safety meetings yearly

Safety Tips

- Do not work in ice, snow or fog
- Face oncoming traffic except on freeways
- Work one side of the highway at a time
- Do not cross the travel sections of the highway
- Pick up on right-of-way only
- Flag syringes and hazardous materials
- Place filled bags off the shoulder of the road
- Stay clear of construction
- Avoid overexertion


