

## Contractors Recognized for Outstanding Public Works Projects

**T**he American Public Works Association recently presented its Public Works Projects of the Year awards, which recognize successful partnerships among public agencies, engineers, architects, consultants and contractors.

Advanced Construction, Inc., Mukilteo, Wash., won in the Historical Restoration/Preservation (\$5–\$25 million) category for its work at Cama Beach State Park for the Washington State Parks & Recreation Commission.

West Coast Contractors, Inc., Fairfield, Calif., won in the Structures (\$25–\$75 million) category for building the Roosevelt Community Center for the city of San Jose, Calif.

Katerberg VerHage, Grand Rapids, Mich., won in the Structures (less than \$5 million) category for building the Rogue River Trail Phase II for the city of Rockford, Mich.

Slayden Construction Group, Inc., Slayton, Ore., won in the Transportation (\$25–\$75 million) category for building the Oregon Department of Transportation's Oregon 8: Elk Creek-Hardscrabble Creek Bundle 401 project.

Sundt Construction, Inc., Tempe, Ariz., won in the Environment (more than \$75 million) category for building the Peoria Butler Drive Water Reclamation Facility for the city of Peoria, Ariz.
