## Map & Directions

### From the North

From I-5 southbound take exit 260A Salem Parkway. Follow the Salem Parkway and signs for “Dallas/Oregon Coast.” Turn right onto Marion St. Bridge [OR-22]. Continue to follow OR-22 west (approximately 4 miles). Turn right on Doaks Ferry Rd. Drive-way to the NWVC is on the left.

### From the South

From I-5 northbound take exit 253. Turn left onto OR-22 (OR-22 becomes Mission St.). Take the 13th St. exit ramp and follow OR-22 signs through Salem. Take a right onto Front St. Take the Marion St. Bridge (OR-22) exit. Continue to follow OR-22 west. Turn right on Doaks Ferry Rd. Driveway to the NWVC is on the left.
