



## 82nd Avenue Projects

ODOT is constructing several projects on 82nd Avenue (OR 213) over the next few years and planning ways to enhance safety for all travelers. *\*Schedule is subject to change.*

**NE Sandy Blvd. Safety Project:** Starting early 2016\*; upgrades to traffic signal, curb ramps & signage

**Intersection Safety Project** (at E Burnside, SE Stark, SE Washington, SE Yamhill, SE Mill and SE Division): Starting early 2016\*; upgrades to traffic signals, curb ramps & crosswalks

**SE Duke St. Safety Project:** Starting fall 2015\*; upgrades to traffic signal, curb ramps & bus pull-out

**Lindy St. to Mt. Scott Creek Bridge Paving and Safety Project:** First phase complete August 2015; second & third construction phases starting spring 2017\*; upgrades to curb ramps & limited sidewalk improvements

**82nd Ave. of Roses Planning Project** (NE Killingsworth to SE Johnson Creek): Planning starting fall 2015\*

**Roses!** In 2005, the highway was renamed “82nd Avenue of Roses.” It connects NE Airport Way Frontage Road in Portland to I-205 in Gladstone.



**Travel safely.** 82nd Avenue is a busy highway, used by trucks, personal vehicles, buses, bikes, and pedestrians. All travelers need to be aware of one another to ensure safe travel.



**The economy is growing.** 82nd Avenue has grown from a small two-lane highway to the busy north/south connection that it is today. With more travelers comes more congestion.



**It takes a team.** ODOT works with partners (City of Portland, Clackamas County, TriMet, and others) to provide a safe, efficient, multi-modal transportation system that supports economic opportunity and a livable community.
