



IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

82nd Avenue (OR 213) is home to a diverse community of residents and businesses and is experiencing rapid change. Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) is looking at the 7.5 mile stretch of 82nd Avenue between NE Killingsworth Street and SE Johnson Creek Boulevard to develop an Implementation Plan that will:


- Identify projects to improve safety for people walking, biking, using mobility devices, taking transit, and driving on 82nd Avenue.
- Identify projects that could be funded and built in the next 5-10 years.

Help us find projects we can build in the next 5-10 years to make 82nd Avenue safer.

The plan will start by identifying high priority locations where improvement ideas will be considered. ODOT will work with the Community Advisory Committee to choose locations that have safety challenges, are key community destinations, and are home to low-income or historically underrepresented residents.

Once ODOT selects the focus areas, the community will help develop and prioritize improvement ideas which could include physical changes like new pedestrian crossings and improved sidewalks, or programs like safety education.


Through stakeholder interviews and other outreach efforts, ODOT has heard from community members about key needs such as improved street lighting, safer pedestrian and bike crossings, more comfortable transit stops, and a more inviting streetscape along 82nd Avenue.
