I-84: Sandy River – Jordan Road – Bundle 210

Updated June 23, 2011

Project summary and location

- Interstate 84 over the Sandy River at Troutdale.
- Replace the I-84 bridges in both directions over the Sandy River at milepost 17.7.
- Repair two bridges over Jordan Road east of the Sandy River at I-84 exit 18.

Purpose and need

- ODOT must replace two and repair two aging bridges in Troutdale to ensure prolonged safety and efficient traffic flow through the I-84 corridor.

Project design

- The new Sandy River bridges will feature rock façade treatments on the bridge piers, abutments and decorative pylons consistent with the I-84 Corridor Strategy aesthetic design guidelines.
- The eastbound bridge over the Sandy River will include a combined bicycle and pedestrian crossing that will accommodate users traveling in both directions.

Construction impacts

- Two travel lanes in each direction of I-84 will be kept open to traffic during construction, but lane alignments will shift.
- Parking and recreational access along the Sandy River and Jordan Road will be affected. Available parking will be reduced.

Key project milestones

- Design complete: November 2009
- Construction start: April 2010
- Construction complete: October 2014

Project cost and funding

- \$73.6 million for design and construction.
- Funding provided by the Oregon Transportation Investment Act. Hamilton Construction Company of Springfield, Ore., is the contractor.
