I-84: Dodson to Tanner Creek bridges

I-84: Dodson – Tanner Creek Bundle 209

Project summary and location

- Interstate 84 west of Cascade Locks between mileposts 35.2 and 40.14 (Dodson, Moffett Creek, and Tanner Creek bridges).
 - Replace the eastbound I-84 bridge over Moffett Creek at milepost 38.98, and realign eastbound I-84 towards the south on either side of the bridge.
 - Repair three other bridges: eastbound I-84 at Dodson at milepost 35.12, and the eastbound and westbound I-84 Tanner Creek bridges at milepost 40.14.

Project purpose and need

- The bridge replacements and repairs are necessary to ensure the prolonged safety and stability of the I-84 corridor as well as efficient traffic flow in the area.

Project design

- The design phase of the project is under way.
- The new bridge at Moffett Creek will incorporate the I-84 Corridor Strategy aesthetic design guidelines for highway improvements. Replacing this bridge will also require a permanent shift of the alignment of I-84 towards the south on either side of the bridge.
- The bridge repairs at Dodson and Tanner Creek will incorporate the I-84 Corridor Strategy aesthetic design guidelines to the extent practicable.

Project construction

- Two travel lanes in each direction of I-84 will be open to traffic during non-work hours.

Key project milestones (Subject to change)

- Final design: January 2009
- Construction start: spring 2009
- Construction complete: fall 2011

Cost of project

- Design and construction budget: \$23.1 million.
- Funded by the Oregon Transportation Investment Act.
