I-84 Sandy River and Jordan Road bridges

I-84: Sandy River – Jordan Road – Bundle 210

Project summary and location

- Interstate 84 over the Sandy River at Troutdale.
 - Replace the I-84 bridges in both directions over the Sandy River at milepost 17.7.
 - Repair two bridges over Jordan Road east of the Sandy River at I-84 exit 18.

Project purpose and need

- The design phase of the project is under way.
- The bridge replacements and repairs are needed to ensure the prolonged safety and stability of the I-84 corridor as well as efficient traffic flow in the area.

Project design

- The new bridges over the Sandy River will be designed using the I-84 Corridor Strategy aesthetic design guidelines for highway improvements.
- The bridge repairs at Jordan Road will incorporate the I-84 Corridor Strategy aesthetic design guidelines to the extent practicable.

Project construction

- Two travel lanes in each direction of I-84 will be kept open to traffic during construction.

Public involvement

- Key stakeholders and the general public will be notified of open house opportunities and kept informed of the project activities through media alerts, project newsletters, and online at www.oregon.gov/ODOT/HWY/REGION1/ColumbiaGorge.
- Public outreach and information for this project will be coordinated with the other I-84 Columbia River Gorge bridge projects from Troutdale to The Dalles.

Key project milestones (Subject to change)

- Design phase starts: May 2006.
- Final design due: winter 2008.
- Construction start: spring 2009.
- Construction complete: December 2012.

Project budget

- \$56.1 million for design and construction.
- Funding provided by the Oregon Transportation Investment Act.
