KEY INFORMATION

Project Location

I-405 from the Fremont Bridge to Marquam Bridge (through downtown Portland)

Key Elements

- Repave I-405 ramps
- Repave I-405 lanes
- Install new lighting
- Install new signs
- Tunnel paving and lighting

Construction Schedule

June—Dec 2009

Tunnel Work

- US-26 E to I-405 N
- NW Everett to I-405 S
- NW Taylor to I-405 S

ODOT has started work on a repaving project on I-405 from the Marquam Bridge to the Fremont Bridge. The pavement is severely rutted and will be filled and paved to improve highway safety. The project will also install new lighting and signs along the I-405 corridor. Work is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2009 and will be performed by Kerr Contractors, Inc. of Woodburn, Oregon. See the back page for more detailed information.

Closures: Construction work will require four weekend full single-directional (north or south) closures, shown in the chart. Single-lane nighttime closures will also occur throughout the duration of the project. During the full directional weekend closures, I-405 will be completely open in the opposite direction. (i.e., when I-405 North is closed, I-405 South will be open).

Scheduled Weekend Closures (*weather dependent*)

Closures take place from 10:00 pm Friday to 5:00 am Monday on I-405 between Fremont and Marquam Bridges

July 25-26	Northbound I-405 lanes and ramps closed (I-405 South will be open)
August 1-2	Northbound I-405 lanes and ramps closed (I-405 South will be open)
August 15-16	Southbound I-405 lanes and ramps closed (I-405 North will be open)
August 22-23	Southbound I-405 lanes and ramps closed (I-405 North will be open)



American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA)



The I-405 Paving Preservation Project uses federal stimulus funds. The total construction cost for the paving project is \$11.6 million. Approximately 30% of the project is funded by stimulus funds. The project initially included funding for lane paving. With federal stimulus funds, work has increased to include lighting, signage, and ramp paving.

Get the most up-to-date information on closures and construction!

Closure and construction schedule is weather dependent. For repaving work, the contractor will use stone matrix asphalt, which requires high summer temperatures and dry climate. If weather forecasts call for unseasonable weather, work may be rescheduled. For more up to date information on ramp and lane closures, please consult Trip Check.

Northbound I-405 Ramp Closures

All lanes and ramps on I-405 north will be closed from the Marquam Bridge to the Fremont Bridge on the weekends of July 25-26 and August 1-2 (see the box on page 1 for closure times). During the northbound I-405 closures, motorists can use I-5 north as an alternate route. Detours for travel via some popular routes are described in the chart below. *(Note that inclement weather may cause a change in the ramp and closure schedule.)*

If you planned to travel via I-405 North from...	Use this route instead..
SW 6th Ave on-ramp to US-26 W	Take 6th Ave N to Clay St W to US-26 W.
SW 6th Ave on-ramp to I-5 N or US-30/I-84 E	Take 6th Ave N for one block to Jackson St W for one block. Take Broadway S to I-405 S to I-5 N. Continue to US-30/I-84 E.
NW Glisan & Couch on-ramp to I-405 N to I-5 N	Take Everett St E to Broadway N, and go across the Broadway Bridge to Williams Ave N to I-5 N.
NW Glisan & Couch on-ramp to I-405 N to US-30	Take 14th Ave N to NW Front Ave N. Take a left on NW Kittridge Ave to US-30.
NW Glisan & Couch on-ramp to I-405 N to I-84 E	Take Everett St E to Broadway N, and go across the Broadway Bridge to Wheeler S. Take I-5 S to I-84 E.
US-26 E to I-5 N/US-30/I-84 E	Take I-405 S to I-5 N. Continue to US-30/I-84E/I-405 S.

Southbound I-405 Ramp Closures

All lanes and ramps on I-405 south will be closed from the Fremont Bridge to the Marquam Bridge on the weekends of August 15-16 and August 22-23 (see the box on page 1 for closure times). During the southbound I-405 closures, motorists can use I-5 south as an alternate route. Detours for travel via some popular routes are described in the chart below. *(Note that inclement weather may cause a change in the ramp and closure schedule.)*

If you planned to travel via I-405 South from...	Use this route instead..
N Kerby Ave on-ramp (Legacy Emanuel Hospital) to US-26 W	Take Vancouver Ave S to I-5 S to I-405 N to US-26 W.
NW Everett St on-ramp to US-26 W	Take NW 16th Ave S to Burnside E. Then take 11th Ave S to Clay St W to US-26 W.
NW Taylor St on-ramp to I-5 S NW Everett St on-ramp to I-5 S	Take 13th Ave S to Market St E to Harbor Dr S to I-5 S.
SW Broadway on-ramp to I-5 S	Take 4th Ave N to Harrison St E to Harbor Dr S to I-5 S.
SW Broadway on-ramp to I-5 N/I-84 E	Take 6th Ave N to I-405 N. Continue to I-5 N/I-84 E.
SW 5th Ave on-ramp to I-5 N/I-84 E	Take 4th Ave N to Alder St E and go across The Morrison Bridge to I-5 N/I-84 E.
US-26 E to I-5 S/I-84 E	Take I-405 N to I-5 S. Continue to I-5 S/I-84 E.

Project Elements

I-405 Paving

- **Four weekend full single-directional (north or south) closures** will be required for paving work. The table on the front indicates scheduled weekend closures. **ALL CLOSURES ARE WEATHER DEPENDENT.**
- Full roadway closures will take place between 10:00 pm Friday and 5:00 am Monday on the indicated weekends. During these times, I-405 will be closed in one direction from the Fremont Bridge to the Marquam Bridge. *(see chart on page 1 for more details).*
- The I-405 project does not include any work on the Fremont or Marquam Bridges.
- Single lane closures may occur at night throughout the duration of the project.

Ramp Work

- Single lane closures will occur on the ramps at night throughout the duration of the project.
- Ramp paving will primarily take place during the full weekend closures. Some ramps may be paved during nighttime hours during the course of the project.

Lighting

- All existing lighting along I-405 will be replaced.
- Three ramp tunnels will receive new permanent lighting.
- One tunnel at a time can be closed from 10:00 pm – 5:00 am for light installation work. Each tunnel may require up to several weeks of nighttime closures.
- Single lane closures may occur at night throughout the duration of the project.

Sign Replacement

- Sign replacement work on I-405 may require single-lane nighttime closures.
- Sign replacement on two cantilever sign structures may require single lane closures on local streets under the structure.
