ODOT to host open house to update the community

ODOT is continuing design on the U.S. 26: Glencoe Road Interchange project, which includes:

- Replacing the Glencoe Road bridge over U.S. 26 with a new, four-lane bridge, and improving vertical clearance
- Improving pedestrian and bicycle connections on the new bridge
- Lengthening and widening the U.S. 26 westbound off-ramp
- Replacing the culvert on Glencoe Road to the north of the interchange with a new structure
- Improving intersections, including traffic signals, signing, striping, drainage and water quality

ODOT invites you to an open house to learn more about the project, **including construction staging and detour information**. Staff will be on-hand to discuss the project in more detail, answer your questions, and take comments. See reverse for more information.
