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# Road Work At Night

## OR 224: SE 17th Ave. – Interstate 205

A contractor working for the Oregon Department of Transportation will move to full construction on a project to improve OR 224 (Milwaukie Expressway) from S.E. 17th Avenue to Interstate 205. Night work is scheduled to start Sunday, July 16 and continue as required through the beginning of September.

### Work on project will include:

- ☆ Paving and striping the highway -- **Work is currently scheduled to proceed from the east to the west ends of the project -- day and night work**
- ☆ Replacing the median barrier, guardrail and various bridge joints -- **Some, but not all of this work can be done during the day**
- ☆ Upgrades to the traffic and pedestrian signals -- **Daytime work**
- ☆ A new sidewalk from Harrison Street to Oak Street and additions or improvements to the curb ramps throughout the project corridor -- **In progress, daytime work**
- ☆ Two new water quality swales -- **Completely off of the roadway: no impact to traffic**

Motorists should expect overnight lane closures and minor delays throughout the project corridor during the construction period. The project is slated for completion by the end of December 2006.
