


# Join Us at the Barbur Concept Plan Open House to Learn More About the I-5 Viaduct Replacement Project

Construction began during the summer of 2010 to replace the I-5 viaducts that cross the ravine at SW Iowa Street. The viaduct columns and superstructure did not meet current roadway or seismic standards and the deck was in poor condition and needed to be replaced.

So far, the project has included the construction of a retaining wall and a temporary bridge just to the west of the existing viaducts, and the demolition of the former northbound viaduct. Most recently, crews have been building retaining walls along the east side of I-5 and construction of the new northbound viaduct will begin in May. Construction is scheduled to continue through the spring of 2014.

The Interstate 5: Iowa St. Viaduct Replacement project is at milepost 298, just north of the Terwilliger Curves. The viaduct – technically two viaducts side-by-side – was completed in 1957, with three lanes in each direction and standard three-foot shoulders. The new viaduct will include standard shoulder widths and maintain three lanes in each direction.
