

I-5 Iowa Viaduct Project

A contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation has started work on a **three-year project** to replace the Interstate 5 Viaduct that crosses the ravine at SW Iowa St. in Portland, just north of the Terwilliger Curves (milepost 298). The replacement viaduct will maintain three lanes in each direction of I-5, with 12-foot shoulders, wider center medians, higher concrete barrier and retaining walls along the freeway. During construction, SW Trail 3 that travels under the I-5 Iowa Viaduct will be closed for safety reasons. The detour routes outlined on this flier will enable pedestrians to travel to and from the Terwilliger Boulevard trailhead to SW Iowa Street/SW Corbett Street.

SW Trail 3 DETOURS

FROM TERWILLIGER

North Detour 2.7 Miles:

- Follow Terwilliger North
- Right on Hamilton St
- Right on Corbett to Iowa St

South Detour 2.0 Miles:

- Follow Terwilliger South
- At Southeast end of Terwilliger Bridge, take stairs down to 4th Ave
- Cross 4th Ave, left on SW Trail 4 to Custer St
- Follow Custer St East
- Left on Corbett to Iowa St

FROM IOWA/CORBETT

North Detour 2.7 Miles:

- Follow Corbett North
- Left on Hamilton St
- Left on Terwilliger to George Himes Park

South Detour 2.0 Miles:

- Follow Corbett South
- Right on Custer
- Continue on SW Trail 4
- Cross 4th Ave, continue up stairs to Terwilliger
- Follow Terwilliger North to George Himes Park
