OR 219 Around-the-Clock Closures Start Monday

ODOT will close OR 219 between Wood Street and Tongue Lane until Friday afternoon

ODOT maintenance crews will close Oregon Highway 219 (Hillsboro-Silverton Highway) between Wood Street and Tongue Lane starting 6 a.m. Monday, June 13 and ending 6 p.m., Friday, June 17.

While the highway is closed, crews will rebuild a section of roadway along the northbound lane of OR 219 north of Morlion Street (milepost 1.5) just south of downtown Hillsboro. This section of roadway failed after heavy rains this past January.

Detour: During the OR 219 closure, motorists will follow a signed detour using Grabel Road, Minter Bridge Road and OR 8.

Access from Oregon Highway 8 (Tualatin-Valley Highway) to Clean Water Services and Jackson Bottom Wetlands will remain open during this closure.
