TRAFFIC ADVISORY

Weekend lane and ramp closures

Rock fall cleanup and maintenance work will close off-ramps and traffic lanes

Oregon Department of Transportation crews will close travel lanes and ramps this weekend to perform repairs. The work will take place as follows:

- Beginning **Wednesday, March 4**, crews closed the northbound right lane on Highway 99E south of the tunnel at Oregon City due to a rock fall. The closure is expected to continue through the weekend to allow crews to perform cleanup and repair work.
- **Sunday, March 8**, ODOT crews will repair light poles on I-205 at the U.S. 30 Bypass exits. **The repair work will require a right lane closure on the southbound I-205 exit to U.S. 30 Bypass eastbound (exit 23A) and a full closure of the northbound I-205 off-ramp to U.S. 30 Bypass westbound (exit 23B). The closures will take place during work hours of 6 a.m. to noon.** Motorists traveling to U.S. 30 Bypass westbound (exit 23B) from I-205 northbound will be detoured to the U.S. 30 Bypass eastbound Sandy Blvd. (exit 23A) to N.E. 99th Avenue northbound to U.S. 30 Bypass westbound. Please expect minimal delays during the ramp closure.
- Multnomah County will close the Morrison Bridge on **Sunday, March 8, from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.** ODOT crews will close the I-5 southbound entrance to the Morrison Bridge/City Center during the bridge closure. The ramp to Oregon 99E/U.S. 26 eastbound (exit 300) will remain open during the closure.
