## **Highway 99W sidewalk project beginning soon**

*Motorists should expect delays on Highway 99W in Tigard through June*

Oregon Department of Transportation is beginning work next week on a \$650,000 project to add and upgrade sidewalks in 5 locations on Highway 99W in Tigard. Project completion is slated for June 2009. Sidewalks will be widened and upgraded to meet ADA standards at the following locations:

- Hwy 99W at the OR 217 northbound on-ramp
- Hwy 99W at the OR 217 southbound off-ramp
- Hwy 99W at 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue (west side of the highway)
- Hwy 99W from McDonald St. to Gaarde St. (east side of the highway)

In addition, approximately 600 feet of new sidewalk and a planter strip will be built on the west side of Highway 99W from Gaarde St. to Canterbury Lane.

### **Traffic Impacts**

Highway 99W will remain open at all times with **nighttime lane closures throughout the duration of the project**. During daytime work hours, motorists will experience traffic pattern changes, but all lanes will remain open. There will also be temporary sidewalk closures. Pedestrians will be detoured across the street to the opposite sidewalk. Motorists should expect delays while traveling on the highway.

The contractor for the project is Civil Works NW Inc. of Vancouver, WA.
