



Highway 35 Closure Alert

October 1st - 3rd

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) will close Highway 35 at milepost 62, approximately 5 miles north of the Highway 35/U.S. 26 (Mt. Hood Highway) junction, Monday, October 1st at 5:00 a.m. through Wednesday, October 3rd at 8:00 p.m. The full closure is necessary to install a five-foot-tall overflow culvert pipe at Iron Creek.

During heavy rain events, the main culvert pipe frequently overflows allowing water to cross Highway 35. The new overflow pipe will provide another outlet, keeping water off the roadway in most events.

During the culvert work, motorists traveling from Hood River to Government Camp or U.S. 26 have two detour options:

- I-84 westbound to Troutdale to U.S. 26
- I-84 eastbound to The Dalles to Highway 197 southbound to Highway 216 westbound to U.S. 26

The Iron Creek culvert enhancement work is part of a 13-culvert repair and replacement project that was designed in the wake of last year's debris flow event on Highway 35.
