Update: emergency paving on I-205 postponed

Paving scheduled to begin tonight will start tomorrow night

The contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation has rescheduled pavement repairs to Interstate 205. The work repair damaged pavement on I-205 caused by chains during last winter's snowstorm will begin tomorrow night, June 24.

The paving work will require lane and ramp closures on I-205 nightly from 8:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning starting tomorrow night, through Saturday night, June 27 and will take place as follows:

- Wednesday, June 24 crews will pave the right and center lanes of I-205 southbound from Sunnybrook Boulevard to Oregon Highway 224. The left lane will remain open. This work will require closing the Sunnybrook Boulevard and Sunnyside Road on and off-ramps (exit 14) to I-205 southbound and the Highway 224/S.E. 82nd Street off-ramp (exit 13).
- Thursday, June 25 crews will pave the right and center lanes of I-205 northbound from Sunnybrook Blvd. to Sunnyside Road. The two left lanes will remain open. This work will require closing the Sunnybrook Boulevard and Sunnyside Road (exit 14) on and off-ramps to I-205 northbound.
- Friday, June 26 crews will pave the right and center lanes of I-205 northbound from Sunnyside Road to Johnson Creek Boulevard. The two left lanes will remain open.
- Saturday, June 27 crews will pave the two left lanes of I-205 southbound at Otty Road. The right and center lanes will remain open.

Please watch for crews and equipment on the roadway.

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
