## Final I-405 weekend closure

Motorists should expect weekend detours and possible delays during I-405 North closure this weekend

ODOT will close I-405 northbound from the Fremont Bridge to the Marquam Bridge **Friday, Sept.11 at 10 p.m. through 5 a.m. Monday, Sept.14.** This is the last of four weekend closures to pave, add new lighting and upgrade signage on I-405. Kerr Contractors, Inc. of Woodburn, Oregon is working on the \$11.6 million project. Kerr will pave a total of four miles and use more than 14 thousand tons of asphalt to complete the project.



**I-405 southbound will be open at all times during the weekend closure, with one ramp exception:** the S.W. Montgomery on-ramp to I-405 southbound will be closed this weekend to keep the increased traffic on I-405 southbound flowing smoothly. The closure is subject to change due to weather or other factors. The project is scheduled to be completed by the end of the year.

### Detours

During the I-405 closure, motorists will be able to use I-5 as an alternate route.

Detours using city streets will help motorists reach downtown businesses.

### Federal Stimulus Funds

Federal stimulus funds in the **American Recovery and Reinvestment Act** account for about 30 percent of the \$11.6 million project cost.
