### **Cleanup work continues on I-84 east of Multnomah Falls**

*Granite Construction will continue asphalt spill cleanup through tonight*

**Cleanup efforts due to an overturned tanker earlier this week require a right lane closure on Interstate 84 eastbound (mile post 38) seven miles east of Multnomah Falls. The right lane will be closed through Saturday, the left lane will remain open.**

Granite Construction who is responsible for the cleanup, is coordinating with Cascade Bridge to grind through the spilled asphalt. The cleanup operation will begin today at 5 p.m. and continue to 8 a.m. tomorrow morning, July 11. ODOT expects to open all lanes on I-84 by 8 a.m. tomorrow morning.
