Ross Island Bridge ramp to OR99E closed

Repairs close the southbound ramp from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday

Oregon Department of Transportation crews will close the eastbound **Ross Island Bridge (U.S. 26 Mt. Hood Highway) off-ramp to southbound Oregon Highway 99E (McLoughlin Boulevard)** daily from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday, Jan. 30 through Friday, Feb. 3.

Detour:

Motorists traveling east on the Ross Island Bridge to Highway 99E south will continue across the Ross Island Bridge, which becomes Southeast Powell Boulevard, then take the connecting ramp to 17th Avenue and continue south on 17th Avenue to Highway 99E.

Crews need to close the ramp to perform repairs on drainpipe.
