REMINDER: Macadam Ave. (Highway 43) ramp to I-5 south to close for bridge rail project

Macadam Ave. ramp to Hood Ave. & I-5 south will be closed on upcoming weekends

This weekend, a contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation will continue work to install concrete barrier and upgrade the bridge railing on the ramp connecting northbound Macadam Avenue (Highway 43) to Hood Avenue and southbound Interstate 5. Crews also will replace a crash impact attenuator at the ramp entrance on Macadam Avenue. **During the work, the ramp will be completely closed to all traffic (it will be open during all non-work periods).**

Schedule

Work is scheduled to take place as follows:

- ◆ **9 p.m. on Friday, April 4, to 5 a.m. on Monday, April 7**
- ◆ **9 p.m. on Friday, April 11, to 5 a.m. on Monday, April 14**

Detour

During the ramp closures, northbound traffic on Macadam Avenue headed for southbound I-5 can travel north on Naito Parkway, south on Market Street to I-5.
